

Change of Major Criteria Biomedical Engineering

To change to the major of Biomedical Engineering, you must:

1. Have completed Math 21A, 21B, 21C, Physics 9A, Chemistry 2A or their equivalents on a letter-graded basis;
2. Have a minimum GPA of 2.7 in all course work listed above; and
3. Have a minimum overall UC GPA of 2.70

Because of the Math requirement above, most first year students apply for a change of major in the Fall Quarter of their **sophomore year**. If you have completed or met the equivalent of ALL the above course work through community college courses, AP credit, etc., it may be possible for you to change during your freshman year.

Please bring your complete Change of Major petition (available at <http://registrar.ucdavis.edu/PDFFiles/D043ChangeMajor.pdf>) to the Biomedical Engineering Department Office for review and signature. After you have obtained signatures from BME, former major, and former college, the petitions must be submitted to the College of Engineering.
